Bee Happy Farm is a recently established working farm which is nestled between 2 secluded glens, locally known as Big Glen and New Glen, in the beautiful rural community of Big Baddeck. The farm was established in 2013 and it has been expanding each year as old agricultural fields and woodland are being carefully developed into a sustainable organic farming business. Currently, Bee Happy Farm is the only registered farm in the 'glens'.

Bee Happy Farm is owned and operated by Iris Kedmi and Lennan MacIsaac. Working together, Iris & Lenny are in the process of bringing their abandoned fields and woodlands back to life by using organic and low maintenance farming methods to raise crops of garlic, herbs, blueberries and hops. The adjoining woodlands are producing cultivated and wild mushrooms, while beekeeping on the farm is used for pollination which increases the crop yield.

Bee Happy Farm also specializes in developing and producing products from wild native plants and herbs which are found in abundance in the glen. The wild native plants are carefully and sustainably harvested from the fields and woodlands on the farm and they are later processed and used in products developed by Iris. The ultimate goal of Bee Happy Farm is to work hand-in-hand with nature in order to organically grow and sustainably harvest both cultivated and wild plants, which are then used in products that are developed to appeal to modern markets.
